- Check local codes before installation to ensure compliance.
- Correct installation of the ceramic fiber logs, proper location of the heater and periodic cleaning are necessary to avoid potential service problems with sooting.
- Keep small children and animals away from the open flame of the gas log set at all times.
- There may be a start-up odor associated with the heating of the logs. The odor should diminish in 2-3 hours of operation with the burner at its highest setting.

The Hearth Heater has been tested and approved by CSA as an unvented room heater to the latest ANS Z21.11 requirements. Approved for installation in an aftermarket manufactured (mobile) home, where not prohibited by state or local codes.
